*Hope for Haiti* is a Naples, Florida based 501(c)(3) charitable organization that has been committed to serving the Haitian people for over 20 years with the mission to improve the quality of life for the Haitian people, particularly children, through education, nutrition, and healthcare.

## Emergency Response



In addition to supporting on-going education, nutrition, and healthcare programs, *Hope for Haiti* has responded to the needs of the Haitian people in the aftermath of earthquake since January 12th in the following ways:



- Sent six 757 Arrow Cargo planes and one DC-10, delivering and safely distributing over \$20 million/400,000lbs in medications, medical supplies, food, water, and construction materials to healthcare centers and tent camps for Internally Displaced People (IDP).
- Ten private planes have flown to Port-au-Prince and Les Cayes, transporting several teams of emergency medical volunteers and life-saving healthcare supplies.
- Distributed over 600,000 meals to *Hope for Haiti* sites within the earthquake impact area.
- Organizing on-going public and primary healthcare through static and mobile clinics within IDP camps throughout Port-au-Prince.
- Employing Haitian medical and support staff to respond quickly and effectively to the needs of IDP communities within Port-au-Prince and Les Cayes.
- Evaluating *Hope for Haiti*'s 37 school buildings in collaboration with local engineers to assess damage.



### Immediate Needs:

- Primary healthcare supplies (a full list of medical supplies is available on *Hope for Haiti*'s website).
- Funding to support the purchase and shipment of life saving healthcare supplies to Haiti. A **\$1,000** donation can send **\$50,000** worth of medications and medical supplies.

# Programs for 2009-2010

## Education:

- Supporting 37 schools with 500 teachers and approximately 12,000 students.

## Nutrition:

- Saving the lives of over 5,000 children annually under the age of 5 who suffer from severe malnutrition (includes pre- and post-natal care, lab testing, education and community outreach).

## Healthcare:

- Distributing over \$20 million worth of vitamins, medications, and supplies to over 60 healthcare facilities annually, providing better quality medical care in partnership with our medical teams and Infirmary to those who need it most.

*Hope for Haiti* works closely with other NGOs, businesses, churches, government, and the local Haitian communities to improve the coordination and delivery of services in the areas in which it is involved.



## Sample Assistance Opportunities

**\$100** Provides one week's supplies (includes food, water purification tablets, candles, matches, detergent, and hygiene supplies) for a family in the event of an emergency.

**\$500** Allows \$25,000 worth of vitamins, medications, and medical supplies to be shipped and safely distributed which would not otherwise be available to our network of healthcare facilities.

**\$1,000** Meets the needs of an entire classroom for one year (teacher and school supplies).

**\$1,500** Makes health services available to a school or community where no modern medical care exists.

**\$2,500** Provides the cost to operate a nutrition clinic for one month, saving the lives of over 400 children under the age of 5 who are suffering from severe malnutrition.

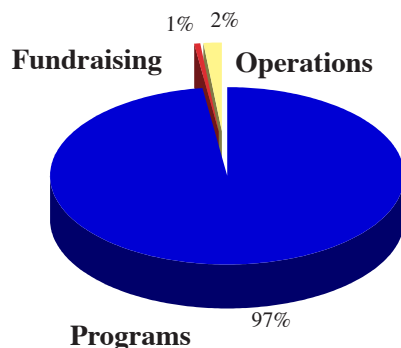
**\$7,500** Supports an entire school for one year, providing access to a quality education to over 300 boys and girls.

**\$20,000** Allows a 40 foot container of medical equipment and supplies to be shipped worth \$1 million.
