Hope for Haiti Cooking School Graduates Sixth Class of Students

Hope for Haiti's Cooking School, overseen entirely by Support Team Manager and Cooking School Director Carmene Alverbe, has now graduated six classes and 26 young men and women. Beginning in 2009, the Cooking School was developed as an effort to support men and women in the community by teaching them marketable skills. Graduates of the Cooking School have gone on to find jobs in various homes and restaurants in Les Cayes, and several have even started their own businesses.



June 2013 graduates proudly display their certificates. Hope for Haiti's Healthcare Program Director, Jennifer Lang, participated this year as a student. Congratulations!

Recipes are not the only component of Carmene's curriculum. Also important are topics such as proper food preparation and sanitation, creating balanced meal plans, planning and budgeting, and presentation techniques. Classes are held each Saturday afternoon for a period of fifteen weeks, and culminate in a final test where students



present their dishes to a panel of judges. Upon passing this test, students receive a certificate of completion, which helps them find jobs in local businesses.
