A Thankful Mother Receives the Gift of Nutrition and HOPE for Her Children

The woman smiled, lowering her chin to look at her shoes. She was timid; her voice shook quietly as she spoke. "When I came here," she said in Creole, "I thought my babies were going to die. I had nowhere else to go."

Scenes like this are all too common in Haiti's rural countryside. Toddlers walk around with thinning hair and swollen bellies - symptoms of severe malnutrition. By partnering with three local clinics, Hope for Haiti helps provide over 13,000 beneficiaries with access to Nutrition Programs.

1.5 hours off a paved road in rural Aquin. Most of the mothers walk for hours to get here; the facility really is their last hope.

The twins entered Timoun Kontan in May, barely able to sit up and on constant IV Fluids. Now, six months later, they are nearing the normal weight threshold. They can sit up, crawl, and play, and they have been adjusting to normal food like Pedialyte and crackers. When speaking about their release this month, the twins' mother beamed--"I have followed and participated in the trainings."
