

Hurricane Season 2013 is Underway

The Hope for Haiti offices in Les Cayes, Haiti are currently prepared to respond to crises. Haiti is traditionally vulnerable during hurricane season, which spans from June 1st to November 30th in the Caribbean.



Thanks to your support, 2,500 Emergency Buckets were assembled this past May for immediate response in the aftermath of a disaster. The Buckets contain life-saving products to help support a family of five, including toothbrushes and toothpaste, matches and candles, soap and laundry detergent, water purification tablets and oral rehydration salts, and - most pressingly - food.

Southern Haiti is still reeling after last year's major storms, Hurricanes Isaac and Sandy, which caught us off guard and caused major

flooding and an increase in water-borne diseases like cholera. The flooding led to long-term crop destruction and exacerbated a food crisis, threatening households already suffering from malnutrition. In response, Hope for Haiti shipped 75,000 meals of rice and beans in December 2012 for distribution to our network of over 25 Education and 22 Healthcare partners throughout the South.

This year, we're planning a similar emergency food packing event and need your help! Led by our Next Generation Board, on December 7, 2013, we need sponsors and volunteers to help pack 75,000 meals which will be distributed to the hungry in Haiti following a disaster.
