Hope for Haiti Responds to Tropical Storm Isaac

Thanks to you, families received relief less than 12 hours after Tropical Storm Isaac hit Haiti with heavy rain and strong winds! During hurricane season, we need your help to prepare and respond when families need us the most.

A stock of 1,500 Emergency Buckets is always prepared in advance of a crisis, and it allows us to respond quickly to areas hard hit. After Tropical Storm Isaac, over 400 families received buckets-enough materials to support 2,000 people. Two rural healthcare facilities also received supplies to help prevent and combat the spread of cholera.

Hope for Haiti is currently assembling another 500 buckets in order to be prepared for the next crisis. A single Emergency Bucket contains the basic supplies for a family of 5 to survive for 5 days in
