MOBILIZING RESPONSE IN THE AFTERMATH OF HURRICANE MATTHEW

We are extremely relieved to announce that all of our Haiti team members are safe and accounted for. Our first priority today was to stabilize our affected staff and their families, whose lives and homes have been greatly impacted by Hurricane Matthew. While those efforts remain ongoing, we have officially begun mobilizing relief efforts to our key partners in Les Cayes.

Our team assembled this morning to assess damages and transportation capabilities, clear debris from our facilities, and begin assembly of first aid kits for immediate distribution. We were able to provide staff and accessible program partners with pre-packaged meals and emergency relief buckets (which contain purification tablets, matches, candles, and detergent).

Over the next few days, we will work diligently to reach our program partners in the outlying rural areas, currently cut off from support by storm damage and flood waters. We will be delivering medications, medical supplies, disaster response materials. Please consider making a life-saving gift **TODAY!**
