

HURRICANE MATTHEW: ONE MONTH LATER

A month has now passed since Hurricane Matthew devastated Haiti, leaving families and entire communities without access to food, water, shelter and medical care. Hope for Haiti has been actively responding to these needs and here are some key highlights of our emergency relief efforts to date:

- Reached 20,000 people in over 20 different communities throughout the Greater South of Haiti
- Distributed over 3,300 Emergency Relief Buckets to vulnerable families
- Delivered over 1.2 million meals to the affected area courtesy of [Convoy of Hope](#), [Cross International](#) and [Food for Kidz](#)
- Generated 75,000 gallons of clean water
- Treated over 1,000 patients at the Infirmary St. Etienne
- Organized a Boeing 767 that airlifted over 86,000 pounds of medicines and medical supplies, facilitated by [Airlink](#) with donations from [Americares](#), [Map International](#), [International Relief Teams](#), and [MedShare](#)
- Facilitated a shipment of 11 pallets of medical supplies from [CMMB](#)
- Mobilized helicopter drops of over 32,000 pounds of food products in coordination with [Bell Helicopter](#) and [Airlink](#)

With the aid of [Team Rubicon](#), we were able to perform rapid needs assessments, clear roads of debris and gain access to our partner communities that were severely affected by the storm. As we move into the rehabilitation phase of our response, Team Rubicon organized the rebuilding of structures in four of our key partner school communities. One temporary school building has already been completed and School Director, Mr. Desir, couldn't be happier. "The whole population thinks the building is very beautiful and it will serve as a model for future buildings. They love it!"

All of you who have supported Hope for Haiti in the past month and over the past 27 years have made these life-saving efforts possible. Thank you!
