In 2010, we fulfilled our mission by:

Giving the Gift of Education

 Ensured that <u>500 teachers</u> received salary subsidies, thereby enabling <u>12,000 children</u> to attend school at <u>37 primary and secondary schools</u>.

Bringing Malnourished Children Back to Health

• Saved the lives of over 5,000 severely malnourished children under the age of five, and supported operations and capacity building in three nutrition clinics.

Providing Quality Healthcare to the Poorest of the Poor

- Distributed over \$50 million in medications and medical supplies to over 60 sites.
- Completed <u>20,000 patient visits</u> in first year of operations at the Infirmary.
- Conducted over 12 mobile medical clinics to rural communities.
- Provided <u>emergency medical care to over 100 individuals</u> through the Robert E. Hord Emergency Medical Fund.

Bolstering Community Development

- Renovated a Port-au-Prince bakery that provides bread to a school, orphanage, and entire community by offering a source of income to women who sell it in the market.
- Provided <u>clean water to 12 schools</u>, <u>clinics</u>, <u>and orphanages</u>.
- Cultivated over 5,000 seedlings to help reforest the mountains of Aquin.
- Completed the <u>fourth class of Cooking School</u>, training young women and men in professional and life skills.

Responding to the Earthquake with Recovery and Rebuilding

- Distributed over 1,000 Emergency Buckets to survivors.
- Safely shipped, stored, and distributed over \$30 million worth of aid, emergency supplies, and medical materials within the first 6 months after the quake.
- Established <u>a clinic in a tent camp</u>, <u>serving over 10,000</u> displaced people. Hope for Haiti recently participated in surveys of post-earthquake fundraising efforts conducted by <u>Charity Navigator</u>, America's largest independent charity evaluator, and the <u>Chronicle of Philanthropy</u>, a premier news source of the non-profit world.
