## What has Hope for Haiti done since January 12th?

We made a promise to long-term relief and recovery in partnership with the Haitian people. So far, we have:

- Safely distributed over \$30 million worth of emergency aid to over 100 sites;
- Established an emergency Haitian staffed clinic that served 10,000 displaced residents;
- Sent specialized medical volunteers to care for earthquake survivors;
- Repaired and renovated two schools in time for the beginning of the 2010-2011 school year;
- Restored a local bakery, providing bread to the Port-au-Prince community;
- Built temporary structures at both a destroyed school and a Nutrition clinic;
- Supported 40 schools, 10,000 students, and 400 teachers;
- Trained 24 Community Health Workers to educate over 2,100 students and their communities;
- Responded to Hurricane Tomas with emergency relief to benefit approximately 1,500 people;
- Distributed medications and public health outreach in response to the Cholera epidemic;
- Forged partnerships with many private and public organizations working on the ground;
- Shared logistical support and local knowledge to leverage Hope for Haiti's relief capacity.

## What are Hope for Haiti's goals for continued recovery and development?

- 1. To increase access to medical care and expand public health outreach
- 2. To strengthen and build capacity within our education program
- 3. To construct and repair affected program buildings (schools, clinics, and homes)
- 4. To expand clinical services offered at the Hope for Haiti Infirmary in Les Cayes
- 5. To enhance and expand inter-organizational partnerships and coordination
