# Hope for Haiti's Healthcare Team Tackles Emergency Medical Care

Hope for Haiti's Emergency Medical Relief Program, named in memory of the initiative's generous donor, Robert E. Hord, provides urgent care to those in serious need. Through the

Hope for Haiti
Infirmary as well as our partner schools and healthcare facilities, we identify people whose lives are threatened by even the most easily treatable health problems. The rest is simple: we do

whatever it takes to get them the care they need, before it's too late.

After being examined by *Hope for Haiti* doctors, our patients are given full support for treatment and medications, either directly at our clinic or indirectly through our relationships with healthcare specialists throughout the country. Lately, we've found the most prevalent cases to be severe diabetes and painful hernias. Women in particular have been treated for breast and uterine tumors, while many men have been identified with inflamed prostates or prostate cancer. The rainy season has increased the number of children suffering from pneumonia, many cases of which are so severe that a family's inability to buy medications can literally dictate the outcome of their child's life.
