

CHOLERA OUTBREAK

138 deaths and over 1,526 new cases of Cholera have now been officially confirmed by the Haitian Government. Response is needed immediately and time is of the essence. With proper hydration and medication the death rate can be dropped from 50% to under 1%. Lives can be saved, but the time is NOW.



Hope for Haiti is taking immediate action to prepare our supported healthcare and education partners with the necessary information and resources to recognize and treat cases that arise in the south of Haiti. Currently, Hope for Haiti has the supplies on hand to treat Cholera cases at our Infirmary in Les Cayes, but more medication is needed, and it is needed NOW (i.e. IV Fluids, Antibiotics, Water Purification Tablets, Hygiene Kits, etc...).
