

One of the ways that we support the 24 schools in our Education Program is by monitoring the quality of teaching. In Haiti, approximately 75% of all teachers lack adequate training; many have just a 9th grade or 12th grade education, with teacher training at no all (World Bank 2007 Project Appraisal Document for Education for All Program). This is why our Education Program not only helps with teacher salaries, supplies and infrastructure, but offers ongoing training for teachers!

This past month, clustered in three locations, 134 Hope for Haiti teachers received 30 hours of training three days French, over in **Mathematics** and Lesson Planning. The teachers came from different schools with a wide range of resources, some have constant electricity while others are located hours off the power grid. Regardless of access to water or electricity, when it comes to the heart of Haitian teachers, they all expressed to us how valuable this training was, because now they can provide a better education for their students. After the training was over, the teachers were motivated and excited to put their new knowledge into action; they also all wanted to know when they can expect the next training!



Did you know?

In Haiti, less than 20% of schools
have electricity; 39% have potable water; 15% have a library (HICF Report 2004).
