November in Haiti can be described in one word: Rainy! For many Haitians living in areas with weak infrastructure, who already have limited access to clean water, the rainy season is a challenging period that causes flooding, contaminates water sources, and spreads disease. That's why our Clean Water program team takes precautions during the rainy season and throughout the year to make sure our clean water sites are functioning to provide pure, great tasting water!

At one of our sites, a combined elementary, middle, and high school, we've installed a GE water purification system that produced over 4,000 gallons last month. The 6-faucet water fountain was created for the 400 students that attend the school and provides cool and safe drinking water for them throughout the day. The teachers also fill up large drinking containers that are placed

throughout the school grounds. Access to clean water facilitates improved sanitation and most importantly, keeps kids healthy and in school.
