Trained at a dental school in Port-au-Prince, Haiti, Dr. Esperance Dupervil is in her sixth year of working for Hope for Haiti. For many Haitians, access to dental services is a challenge because Haiti lacks qualified dentists and patients do not have the money to pay for care.

"In Haiti, there is about one dentist for every 20,000 patients," noted Dr. Esperance.

At our Infirmary St. Etienne, we work to provide more Haitians with access to quality care through our devoted and qualified dental team. By lowering consultation fees to only 15 Haitian Gourdes (equivalent to about 30 cents) and providing free medication, we are improving access and helping to keep Haitian smiles happy and healthy.

The most common service we provide is tooth extractions – from patients two years old to 80 years old. Often times, many people wait too long before seeking proper dental care, living with chronic pain. Dr. Esperance wishes that patients would come more frequently to see her, to lessen these emergencies. Dr. Esperance saw almost 2,000 patients last year!
