Hope for Haiti is mobilizing preparedness efforts in advance of Hurricane Matthew. Our team, consisting of 50+ staff members, is headquartered in Les Cayes. Our Country Director, Willys Geffrard, has activated emergency protocols to ensure the safety of the team and assess and respond to the needs of the organization's over 40 education and healthcare partners in the Greater South of Haiti.



For just \$100, our team can provide an emergency bucket containing supplies for a family to use in the immediate aftermath of an emergency. These buckets contain life-saving supplies including water purification tablets, matches, candles, soap, toothbrushes, toothpaste, and nutrient rich meal packets (Meals of Hope) that can feed a family of five for at least five days. Each item is specifically selected based off of the needs of families in Haiti surviving a storm to keep them safe and healthy until additional support can be provided.

As the situation in Haiti continues to develop, we will assess the needs on the ground and provide emergency assistance when safe to do so.
