Hope for Haiti Celebrates the Power of Hope

Naples, Florida, March 24, 2017 – Hope for Haiti held its annual VIP Breakfast yesterday at the Bellasera Hotel to present their 2016 Annual Report. Generously sponsored by PNC Wealth Management, the event celebrated "The Power of Hope" and showed attendees the impact of Hope for Haiti's work made possible through a tremendous community of supporters.

"More than 28 years of experience teaches us that we are not the providers of hope, but we are facilitators—for Haitian children, parents, and grandparents searching for ways to improve their lives through access to education, healthcare and water, and through improvements in infrastructure and economic opportunity," said Skyler Badenoch, Hope for Haiti's CEO.

Hope for Haiti's FY 2016 Annual Report highlights the organization's impact from the past year. In 2016, Hope for Haiti worked with community leaders to set up 15 computer labs in schools and community centers that impacted the quality of education of over 4,700 students. They employed Haitian healthcare workers who provided 11,705 patients with access to quality health and dental care. Approximately 82,780 gallons of water were filtered for consumption by students and community members in 15 different locations. In the aftermath of Hurricane Matthew, Hope for Haiti's dedicated team was one of the first to respond by quickly repairing 16 schools, providing more than 40,000 people with emergency relief supplies, and distributing more than 100,000 pounds of food to people in acute need of humanitarian assistance.
