Hope for Haiti is an action-oriented and fast-paced organization that believes in partnership solutions to poverty alleviation. Hope for Haiti has a distinguished and well-established Board of Directors that provides the organization with strong governance, oversight, and strategic direction. Role Purpose:

Under the direct supervision of the Chief Impact Officer, The Gift-in-Kind Program Director (GIKD) has the primary responsibility for planning, securing and following through on Giftin-Kind shipments as well as monitoring that shipments were received at planned locations and went to expected beneficiaries. The purpose of the role is to identify potential donors, develop relationships and acquire valuable donations at the local and international levels. The GIKD will collaborate closely with the Chief of Donor Experience to manage GIK donors and partnerships through the donor experience process and coordinate volunteer experiences. The GIKD manages the GIK Manager (GIKM) and team in Haiti.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- 60% Supply Chain Management
 - Ensures appropriate procedures and systems are in place to ensure efficiency of the supply operations. Liaises with GIK Manager including Country Director, to implement new initiatives that align with "do no harm" practices.

- Ensures appropriate planning, implementation, monitoring and evaluation of the supply chain operations. Oversees preparation of documentation. Reviews supply documentation including requisitions, tender documents and contracts/purchase orders (POs).
- o Ensures establishment of supply plans and forecasts, supply source- and availability plans, logistics and distribution plans.
- o Ensures emergency preparedness of supply and logistics for programs in line with Hope for Haiti's Emergency Preparedness policies.
- o Conducts field visits to Haiti offices or project sites, to monitor supplies and propose actions to improve logistics arrangements.
- Research opportunities and develops relationships with national 3rd party logistic firms and trucking companies to build the infrastructure required to support rapid growth on GIK supply chain.
- o Performs other duties as assigned.
- 40% Donor Experience
 - o Maintain high-level relationships and communication with GIK donors.
 - o Secure GIK gifts at all levels with the goal of raising \$11 million annually in GIK and \$100,000 for shipping logistics.
 - o Manage systems and software to track and cultivate donors and prospects, including our donor database .
 - o Work with the development team to align efforts and set goals.
 - o Make direct, face-to-face solicitations, and assist the board and other staff with their solicitation (e.g. provide portfolio development support, strategic counsel, and help with donor communications).
 - o Coordinates content from the field for reporting and auditors.
 - Coordinate and attend in person special GIK events (packs, lunch and learns) at the individual and corporate level in Hope for Haiti's regional hubs (Les Cayes, Naples, Miami, NYC area, Arizona, LA, Boston, etc).
 - o Attend partner meetings and lead Haiti Donor Trips.
 - o Performs other duties as assigned.

EDUCATION / EXPERIENCE

- Passion and enthusiasm for non-profits work, specifically in Haiti.
- Strong understanding of supply chain processes, from programme needs assessment, through planning, category management, procurement and contracting, logistics and delivery, monitoring and evaluation
- Fast learner, adapts and responds to change, tolerates ambiguity.
- Ability to network and establish good relations with stakeholders.
- Knowledge of monitoring and evaluation methodologies
- Knowledge and experience with proposal writing and reporting.
- Must be able to work in a warehouse environment and capable of lifting, pushing, and material handling of 25 pounds or more.
- Ability to use computers, including Gmail Suite (email, google documents, google calendar), Microsoft Word, and Microsoft Excel, Experience in RE, Salesforce or other database platforms.
- Must be eligible to work in the United States.
