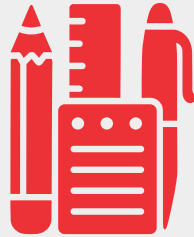

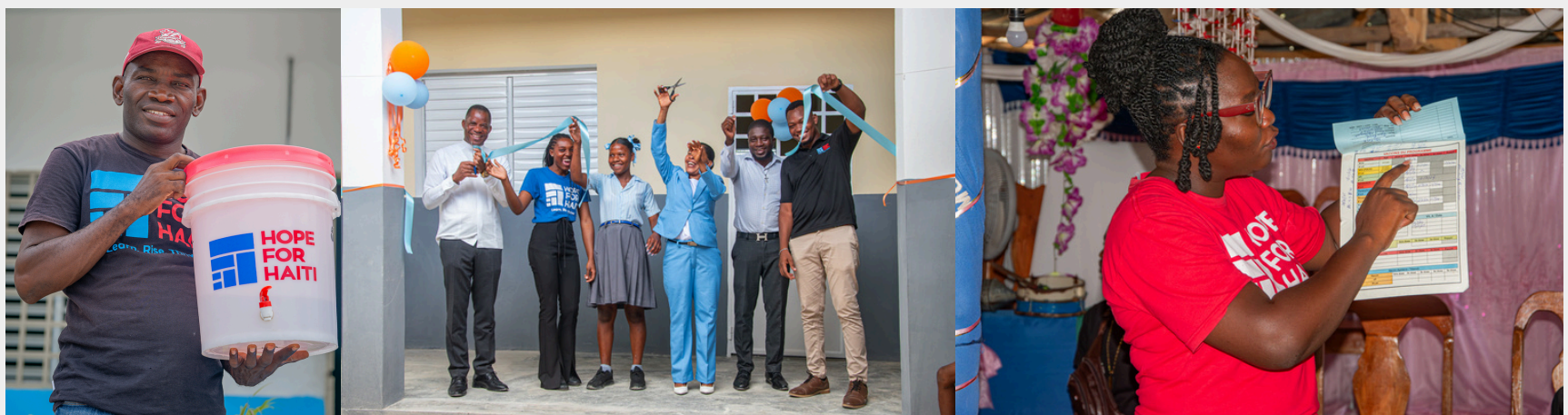

- In May, our clinic recorded 20 new cases of diabetes and 50 new cases of high blood pressure. Some of these patients were enrolled in Chronic Care, ongoing care programs for regular follow-ups, education, and access to necessary medications, including insulin for those with diabetes.

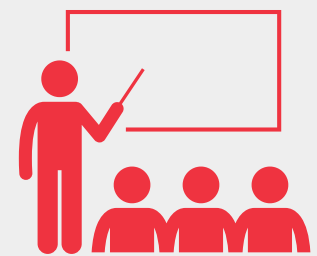

Additional Highlight:

- 125 girls, 153 boys, and 17 farmers were trained this month on basic farming techniques. "This training will provide participants with basic knowledge of agriculture as a key economic sector for Haiti's economic development," said Fleurette Derosier, one of the participants in the training.

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
